You could hop on or drop out at any time up to about six weeks before the conference or the publication date.

You could pick any level of participation that made you comfortable over the six months of the process:

- Review and comment only: half and hour on your bio and an hour and a half review
- Write one paragraph on communications issues in prison setting (or other venue): 3 hours
- Write a page or so on stress impacts of faulty communications: 6 hours
- Write an entire 3 papge section on germane topic: 9 hours
- Take over as primary author and ram-rod the whole thing: 40 hours

Cost: \$0, unless you wan to attend conference and present the paper, then ~\$2K

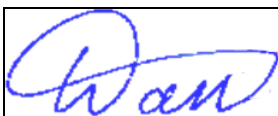
Most of the conferences I attend are fixed: two in Orlando and one in Norfolk (the other floats in the US)
